Advanced and Diploma of Fashion Design and Technology — Course Structure

To receive the Advanced Diploma of Applied Fashion Design and Technology students must complete 11 core units and at least 20 elective modules. To receive the Diploma of Applied Fashion Design & Technology students must complete 6 core units and at least 5 elective modules.

Sample Core Units

- Draw a trade drawing for fashion design
- Apply design studio process
- Interact and network with fashion industry participants
- Develop product specifications for fashion design
- Evaluate commercial viability of designs
- Manage product development of fashion designs
- Manage fashion design process
- Develop a fashion range
- Apply studio processes to create and produce designs for commercial production
- Create and edit digital embroidery designs
- Use colourisation techniques on fabrics
- Develop patterns from a block using basic patternmaking principles
- Identify design process for fashion designs
- Identify influences on contemporary fashion designs and construction techniques
- Create pattern from block to meet customer specifications
- Source materials and resources for production of fashion designs
- Use electronic fashion design tools
- Conduct quality assurance for patterns and garments
- Construct stock size block for garment to meet size and fit specifications
