S9545 Diploma of Hospitality Management (includes Certificate 3 in Commercial Cookery)

This course is for people who want to work as a manager in the hospitality industry. You will also learn how to lead, supervise and manage a team of people. This course includes Commercial Cookery Certificate 3 (2662).

This diploma articulates into a Bachelor of Business and Commerce (Hospitality Management) at the University of Western Sydney. Students who successfully complete the Diploma of Hospitality Management will receive up to a year of credit.
